

A Chamber 'Welcome to Sydney'

In early 2010 as a result of the publication of Chamber's Monitoring, Indauspac and Observations sections on the ACCCI Website an increasing number of inquiries have been received from private and public organisations throughout the region for assistance on matters relating to China.

In addition for Chairmen of Boards and CEOs of Corporations engaged in China trade and investment, commerce and industry, public affairs and media, culture and sport, who visit Sydney for a short few days Chamber can organise senior people to provide commentary at the more significant attractions of our city.
