

## Lin Kun and John Wang Visit Sydney in February 2004

**Lin Kun** has been the ACCCI Chief Representative Beijing since early in 2002. That position was previously held by Mr John Wang. Most Chamber members and friendly organisations will remember Mr Lin Kun as the Head of the Economic and Commercial Office of the Consul General of the People's Republic of China in Sydney for 6 years. He recently retired and is now residing in Beijing.

**John Wang** became Chairman, ACCCI China Liaison Committee when Lin Kun became ACCCI Chief Representative Beijing. John is therefore the senior person for the Chamber throughout China, including Hong Kong SAR and Chinese Taipei. John has associated with the Chamber for many years and was ACCCI Chief Representative in Beijing since 1998.

February 2004 marked the first time that both of the Chamber's key people in China visited Sydney at the same time and that made the visit a special occasion.
